Sec. 9-309. - Appeals.

- (a) Any person or persons aggrieved by any decision, act or proceeding of the historic district commission shall have the right to apply in writing to the mayor and board of aldermen of the town for reversal or modification thereof. The mayor shall have the right to stay all further action until the mayor and board of aldermen may affirm a decision of the historic district commission by a majority vote of all its members. Any such appeal shall be taken within ten days from date of the decision. The mayor and board of aldermen may consider the appeal at its next general or special meeting, but in any event, not more than 45 days thereafter. The mayor and board of aldermen shall have the right to reverse, change or modify any decision of the historic district commission only by two-thirds vote of all members of the board as constituted.
- (b) Any person or persons aggrieved by any decision of the mayor and board of aldermen affecting the historic district shall have the right to file a civil suit within 30 days from the date of decision in a court of competent jurisdiction under the usual rules or procedure governing same, with the right to stay orders and injunctive relief provided the situation warrants it.
